Sharing Papers Between Home and School

We will be greatly reducing the amount of paper that will travel between school and home and back again, however there will still be some items that will need to be shared. The recommended procedure for sharing papers is to sanitize hands prior to and immediately after touching the forms and to set the forms aside for 72 hours before reading/completing. These procedures will also be followed at school when forms are returned.

Absence Reporting

If your child is going to be absent for any reason, please report their absence by one of the following two methods:

Late Arrivals

If your child is going to be late for any reason, please advise the school through one of the 2 ways mentioned above.

If you drop your child off late, please ring the buzzer and someone will meet your child at the main entrance.

We are sending your child's student verification form home to be updated.

We require the most up to date information in our database and would like you to check the form carefully.

Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Medication Information

Any student that takes prescribed medication at school must have an Authorization to Administer Medication form filled out by their Physician for prescription medication and filled in by parent/guardian for non-prescription medication. A new form must be filled out every school year. We must have the completed and signed form, medication in original Pharmacy bottle labelled with dosage and instructions, and the pharmacist medication information sheet on file before we can administer the medication to your child on your behalf.
