

For Families:

COVID-19 isn't the only virus we all want to avoid. A COVID-19 test may not be needed when you only have a runny nose or a sore throat but these symptoms can still spread illness to others. Don't go to school, work or visit others if you are feeling sick. Talk to your health care provider or call the School Health Line at 1-866-236-0123. Complete the school screening tool before each school day at: https://bit.ly/3v8r8RG

My child had a high risk exposure to COVID-19 at school, what do we do? Check your email for a high risk letter from the Health Unit sent by your school or school board. The letter gives instructions on self-isolation, monitoring your child for symptoms, testing, and guidance for household members. Public Health will also be calling you within a 24 hour period to review the information in the letter. Call the School Health line at 1-866-236-0123 if your child had a high risk exposure and has symptoms or if you have urgent questions.
