

A Couple Reminders

Please remember to send in a water bottle daily with your child. We have a water bottle filling station, but the students are not able to drink from the fountain and we have a limited supply of paper cups available.

We also suggest that your child come dressed in layers as the classroom windows are open to help with air ventilation. Each classroom also has a HEPA ventilator running that, along with the windows being open, contributes to a cooler temperature in the classroom.

Updated COVID-19 School Screening: Many changes have been made to the school screening tool since the fall term. Continue to complete the school screening tool every day to decide whether or not your child should be attending school, and for help on what to do next. For advice, you are also welcome to call the Health Unit's school/parent phone line at 1-866-236-0123.

Changes to School Contact Tracing: Public Health will not be dismissing classroom or bus cohorts after someone at the school has tested positive for COVID-19. If a school's absenteeism rate is 30% above their typical baselines, school administrators and public health will work in partnership to enhance existing public health measures and to provide updates to school families and staff.

Individuals only exposed to a COVID-19 positive individual at school with all public health measures in place are encouraged to monitor themselves for symptoms.
