Schools' role in assisting parents for SLP etc.

- The first step is always parents. If the parent(s) notice there is a speech problem, that is something they would look into prior to school. When the student is enrolled in kindergarten in their welcome package is information for Learning Express.
- Language Express is where they go when they are starting school or prior to school
- The part way through JK Language Express send the information to the school. Once they have sent it to the school board the board looks at it decides if it is language or is it articulation. If its articulation, LE will also send it to Kids Inclusive. KI then sends the school and parents a letter saying your child is on a 2-3 year wait list. That is usually for severe articulation. If it's mild and teachers are concerned teachers have an SST meeting and they decide if they are concerned about speech. The board would then see if it has improved, if it does not it gets sent back to another SST meeting and a speech referral is done. If they are getting speech support from Kids Inclusive that means it is an articulation and that is separate from the school board. The school board looks primarily at language, not speech articulation.
- PC members who have been through this with their children feel it needs to be clearer to parents. How can we help parents?

- ➤ Have Kim Lee from the board be here at our meet the teacher nights to talk to parents who may have any concerns and help give them guidance to what steps they need to make.
- > Next year it is all changing. Referrals will come through the board and LE will take a step back.
